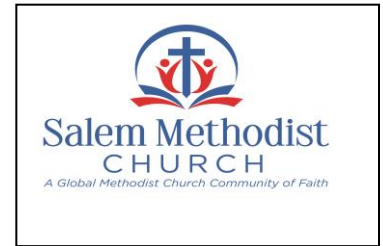

Men Club Scholarship



Introduction

The Methodist Men's Club of Salem Methodist Church provides Scholarships to graduating high school seniors at the end of their spring semester. The Men's Club will award up to two (2) one thousand dollar (\$1,000.00) scholarships. The Scholarships are paid to the Students account at the College or University they will attend. Pays any expense and is not based on financial need. (Paid in addition to other financial aid)

Eligibility

- The applicant is a member of Salem MC, supports it with their service and participation in activities and ministries.
- Graduating high school seniors who are younger than 20 years old
- Scholarships are only available to students attending degree conferring institution

Supporting Documents

- Transcript
- SAT/ACT scores, class standing, GPA
- College/University letter of acceptance
- Essay: Section 5 of Application

Salem Methodist Church, Scholarship Administration

- Scholarship will be paid from the MM account
- Files of scholarship applications will be kept in the Church Office
- Scholarship committee will be made up of the President of the MM and two others who are active members of the MM
- Scholarship recipients will be determined by the committee
- Scholarship program information shall be posted on Salem MC website; www.salemfnc.org
- Student may only earn one scholarship in the student's lifetime unless Scholarship committee deems otherwise
- Scholarship committee members will sequester themselves in cases of conflict of interest
- The Salem Men's Club does all the fundraising for the scholarships. Funds usually come from member dues and donations
